

ARE YOU A YOUNG WOMAN WHO HAS HAD BREAST CANCER?

WE ARE LOOKING FOR WOMEN AGED 18-45

What will participants do?

Participants can complete an **online questionnaire** AND/OR take part in an **in-person interview** that invites participants to think about the ways in which being a survivor of breast cancer may have changed how they see themselves in the world. This may include looking at social roles, being a woman, a worker, or a partner.

The online questionnaire as well as the interview each takes approximately 90 minutes to complete. Participation is confidential.

Eligible participants:

- ✓ Women with primary breast cancer between the ages of 18 to 45
- √ Had either a lumpectomy or mastectomy
- ✓ Completed adjuvant treatment
- √ No history of or current evidence of metastatic disease
- ✓ Women should be comfortable using the English language to communicate

Benefits of the Study/Compensation:

You may find it helpful to talk about your experiences living and coping with breast cancer. Your participation in this study may help to identify practical strategies for other young women beginning their survivorship.
